GEAR LIST *(please put your name on everything)*

Be ready for potentially COLD weather! Forecast calls for a low in the 30s Friday!

- Tent & Ground Cloth: only 2 people to a tent.
- Sleeping bag with a sleeping pad.
- Raingear: always pack this and you will be prepared!
- Clothes:
 - Long pants – 1 pair;
 - Long sleeve shirt;
 - Shorts;
 - Socks, plus an extra pair to sleep in too!
 - Underwear - maybe some thermals;
 - Troop T-shirt;
 - A warm jacket or fleece; and
 - A warm hat to sleep in
- A built and inspected model rocket.
- Hat: Troop hat only (get one at the meeting for \$15).
- Sunscreen: NO aerosol.
- Towel: an old grungy one.
- Bug Repellent: NO aerosol.
- Personal Hygiene Kit: toothpaste & brush, TP, soap, and shampoo.
- Rope: always bring a small piece (20 ft nylon cord is enough).
- Cup: for drinking.
- Plate & utensils: no Styrofoam or disposables
- Flashlight: with extra batteries.
- First Aid Kit
- Pocket Knife: folding blades only.
- Watch: to time your rocket flight
- Canteen: a Nalgeen or two.
- Money: some \$\$ to spend on the trip home if "The Mama" says so.
- Greencard: for advancement.
